A design patent lasts 14 years from the date of the original patent application.

A patent is a property right granted by the Government of the United States of America to an inventor "to exclude others from making, using, offering for sale, or selling the invention throughout the United States or importing the invention into the United States" for a limited time in exchange for public disclosure of the invention when the patent is granted.

EPO Patents for software

If the invention to which an application relates satisfies these criteria, the applicant is awarded a patent, which is a temporary exclusive right preventing others (including competitors) from using the patented invention without the consent of the patent owner. In return for protection the invention must be fully disclosed to the public.
